1.Mind Spark (Paper Presentation) - Rules

Team Formation:

- 1. Each Team must have only 2 participants.
- 2. Team can have participants from different batches.
- 3. Papers must be related to Computer Science / Information Technology, such as:
- A. Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning
- **B. Cyber Security & Digital Forensics**
- C. Data Science & Big Data
- D. Cloud Computing & Virtualization
- E. Internet of Things (IoT)
- F. Blockchain Technology
- **G.Software Engineering / Networking**
- H.Any emerging CS-related domain



Paper Submission Dates:

- 1. Teams registered should send your PPT presentation on or before 14.12.2025
- 2. Students are requested to send their papers to events@measiit.edu.in (Mention your team members name, year, degree and shift in the body section of the mail) Late submissions will not be accepted.

Paper Format Rules:

- 1. Abstract should be at least 6 to 8 lines.
- 2. The front slide should have the title of the paper on the top and the details of the team.
- 3. members at the bottom.
- 4. Font style for text: Times New Roman.
- 5. Title of the paper should be 24 points.
- 6. Abstract font size 9 points and must be bold.
- 7. Font size for headings: 10 points and must be in uppercase.
- 8. Font size for sub-headings: 10 points, italics with title case.
- 9. Content font size 10 points.
- 10. Line spacing 1 point and Paragraph spacing should be 1.5 point.

Presentation Rules:

- 1. The paper submitted will have to be presented during the event.
- 2. The Teams will get 8 minutes to present their topic. And 2 minutes will be for questioning by judges.
- 3. Maximum 12 slides recommended.
- 4. Team members must present equally if in a team.
- 5. Participants must bring the presentation in pen drive or have your presentation in your personal laptop.

2.Idea Vault - Shark Tank (Rules)

- 1. Two members permitted in a team.
- 2. Each team can submit only one project idea.
- 3. One participant cannot be part of more than one team.
- 4. No change of team structure is permitted after the team is registered.
- 5. One of the team members should be registered as team leader.
- 6. The Synopsis of the Project Plan should be submit 2 Days before (Before 14.12.2025) through email mohamed.ajwadh@measiit.edu.in.
- 7. Maximum 15 slides of power point presentation are allowed in the presentation.
- 8. The participants must follow the font size of 12 in Times New Roman for main text.
- 9. For headings with line spacing of 1.5"
- 10. Teams will have a specified time limit (5-8 minutes) to pitch their project idea to the panel of sharks. The pitch must include the innovation and project aspects.
- 11. Two minutes Question round.
- 12. Participants must carry their data back up in laptop.
- 13. Presentations must be clear, concise, and visually engaging.
- 14. Not adhering to the following rules will cause disqualification.

3. Remote Riot- Channel Surfing (Rules)

- 1. Per team can have 5 participants.
- 2. Channels will be given on the spot.
- 3. Performance time will be 5 minutes.
- 4. Any 3 channels will be allotted.
- 5. Properties (if required) must be brought by the participants.
- 6. Language can be multilingual according to the channel.
- 7. Vulgarity in any form will lead to disqualification.



4.Bug Busters- Debugging (Rules)

- 1. Two Participants per team
- 2. Two Rounds Prelims(MCQ) and Finals
- 3. Preferred language C,C++, Java and Python
- 4. Time Duration for prelims will be 30 minutes
- 5. Finals will have 10 teams.

5.Brain Byte- Technical Quiz (Rules)

- 1. Two Participants per team.
- 2. Prelims will be conducted and five teams will be selected for finals.
- 3. Judges decisions should be the final.
